HAZADR project is designed to assist Adriatic States, Regions and Counties in taking actions - individually or jointly within their respective policies priorities and resources — to improve the prevention, reduction, and reaction against the pollution by oil and toxic material spilled at coasts. 13 project partners from Italy, Croatia, Slovenia, Montenegro and Albania, plus many other emergency corps and decision makers, are testing new early warning and predictive applications to make Adriatic coasts safer. #### Joint exercises to combat oil spill at coasts continues

One of the pillar of the HAZADR project is the organization of cross-border exercises on the Adriatic to improve cooperation and harmonize the work of operational staff, especially response teams involved in implementing national and regional contingency plans. After VIREX and ERCOLE, the 3<sup>rd</sup> international exercise is on the pipeline.



#### Slovenian radars in operation in the North Adriatic

An advanced system for current and wave measurements in the northern Adriatic was set up at the Marine Biology Station Piran last year as part of the HAZADR project. Researchers believe the measurements will bring new insights into water flows in the Gulf of Trieste and enable more effective reactions to potential accidents and spills. This action is part of a larger Adriatic radar installation program carried on also in Croatia and Italy.



#### **HAZADR** in the top ten projects of Montenegro

The University of Montenegro organized an important workshop on the 25.03.2015 which aimed at promoting international projects at the University of Montenegro. HAZADR was presented as one of the most important in the field of Adriatic environmental protection. In the meantime, the University of Montenegro is getting ready to implement the international exercise with Apulia Region and the Albanian Ministry of Transport.



### **New round of workshops in Croatia**

While the Adriatic Training and Research Centre is under finalization in Rijeka, Istria and Split-Dalmatia Counties have recently organized some technical workshops to raise reaction capacities in cases of eventual oil spill accidents and to train technicians in the use of the purchased emergency equipment.
